

# Camping Skills

These 2-day, 1 overnight camps are designed to help youth enjoy, appreciate, and have fun in nature. For each camp, we will set off to a destination where we will set up camp, explore the area on foot, learn about nature, and cook over the fire.

## **June 30-July 1: Colorado National Monument Trip: \$75, Ages 9-12**

On day 1, we will drive to the monument where we will hike the rim trail, boulder on the rocks, and learn about local geology. From the campground, we will have a great view of the constellations at night. Day 2 will take us to the outdoor Moyer pool, complete with a 350 foot long water slide and 1 and 3 meter diving boards.

## **July 14-15: Durango Trip: \$85 (includes DMR Activity Fee), Ages 9-12**

We will travel to Haviland Lake Campground where we will set up and go off to hike and explore. At night we will cook and tell ghost stories around the fire. On Day 2 we will head to the Durango Mountain Resort summer activities center where youth will ride the Alpine Slide, jump on the Bungee Trampoline, and climbing on the Climbing Wall.
